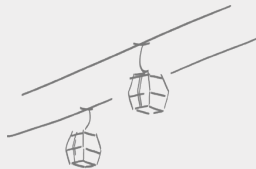
From the 4<sup>th</sup> of June to the 11<sup>th</sup> of October 2026

- > € 51,50 for kids (born 2011 to 2019)

\* Exclusive bike transport, evening tickets and attractions

\*\* A day per Summercard GOLD & person is redeemed (equivalent to a mountain cable car ride)

\*\*\* Children & adolescents must present an ID indicating their age at the time of purchase.

Regardless of whether one or more services are used on a given day, only one day will be redeemed or deducted per person. This means that the card can be used as many times as desired on the valid days.
